

## Privacy and Terms

Clover Foundation and its affiliates ( “Organization”, “we”, “us” or “our”) welcomes you to the website and wants to inform you about the collection, use, and protection of your personal information online. This Privacy Policy (“Policy”) is our policy regarding the information we receive in connection with the <http://clover-foundation.org/> Website (the “Website”). This policy also applies to information you submit to us offline.

**Information We Collect** Clover Foundation collects and retains two types of information about Website visitors: (i) personal information that individual visitors provide when interacting on the Website, or voluntarily at certain other points (such as via forms, letters, telephone, or emails); and (ii) tracking data, which is automatically collected from every Website visitor (See Tracking Technologies, below), (collectively, “Information”). The Information that we gather may include your name, address, telephone number, email address, or other elements of personal information.

**Tracking Technologies** We and others may collect information about your activity on our sites and applications using tracking technologies such as cookies. A cookie is a string of information, including a unique reference code, that a website stores on a visitor’s computer when visiting a website and that the visitor’s browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. Examples of this type of information include information about your computer and Internet connection, such as your operating system and browser type, and details of your visits to our Web Sites, including traffic data, location data, logs and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Website. The information helps us provide useful features to simplify your experience when you return to our sites, analyze web traffic, determine targeted advertisements, facilitate automated activity, and determine appropriate solicitations. Collect You may delete or disable cookies or other technologies to prevent us from collecting the above information. If you do, you may not be able to successfully log on to and participate in many features of

our Website.

**How We Use Your Information** The Information that we collect and that you provide to us is used for our organizational purposes and the purpose for which you provided it, including, without limitation, to respond to your requests or correspondence. The Information may also be analyzed so that we can operate the Website in the best manner possible through enhanced features and functions and to provide you with useful information.

**How We Use E-mail** When you provide your e-mail address to Clover Foundation, we may periodically send you relevant alerts and newsletters by e-mail. Instructions on how to unsubscribe are included in each e-mail.

**How We May Share the Information We Collect** We may share information about you or which you provide us with our affiliates and service providers who we use to support our services and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them. We may share with others aggregated information about our users that does not identify any particular individual.

We may also share your personal information with a sponsor or other third party (“Third-Party Provider”) who may provide you with special offers or promotions that might be of interest to you. You may instruct us at any time not to share your personal information with such Third-Party Providers by emailing us at [info@clover-foundation.org](mailto:info@clover-foundation.org)

Furthermore, we may transfer, assign, or otherwise share your personal information in conjunction with a merger, reorganization, transfer of assets, dissolution, or liquidation of all or part of Clover Foundation.

We may also share your personal information where disclosure is necessary to: (a) comply with legal process (such as a court order) or other legal requirements of any governmental authority; (b) protect our rights or property; (c) protect the interest of users of the Website, other than you, or any other person; or (d) operate or conduct maintenance and repair of our services or equipment, as authorized by law.

**Data Security** No security program is impenetrable and criminals have proven adept at circumventing widely-adopted security safeguards, so we cannot guarantee the security of the personal information you transmit to us. Accordingly, you acknowledge that you do so at your own risk.

**Other Communications** From time to time, we may e-mail Website users information regarding important developments affecting the Organization. We may also e-mail Website users on occasion regarding the Website. Such e-mails may be sent to Website users even if they have not requested to receive any communication from us.

**Links to Third-Party Websites** The Website may contain links to Websites owned and operated by other parties. We are not responsible for and have no control over the privacy policies of those Websites. We encourage you to review the privacy policies of those Websites prior to providing them with any information.

**Children** Clover Foundation does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from users under the age of 13. Children under 13 should not send any information about themselves to Clover Foundation. If a child under 13 submits information through any part of the Website, and Clover Foundation becomes aware that the person submitting the information is a child, we will attempt to delete this information as soon as possible.

**Changes to Our Privacy Policy** We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. We will notify users by posting the new policy on our Website and we will notify you of material changes with an alert on the Website or a communication to you. Please check back here periodically to review our latest policy.
